# EASY ACCESS

## CUMBERLAND TRAIL Via STRID CAR PARK

The signposted Trail starts behind the Strid Shop. Ramped access to the Barn Exhibition, with video and live camera action of birds' nests.  
**Terrain** : Firm. Easy gradients.  
**Distance** : 852m.

## BOLTON ABBEY VILLAGE TO THE PRIORY AND RIVER

From the village green turn left down the road. Turn right down the drive marked 'No Cars'. For the river turn right and take the path down the field in front of the Rectory, or go straight on to visit the Priory.  
**Terrain** : Firm path. No steps into the church.  
**Distance** : 380m.

## DEVONSHIRE SEAT

Behind the Tea Cottage, this seat gives a panoramic view of the Priory and river.  
**Terrain** : Firm path.

## CAVENDISH PAVILION TO THE STRID

From the Pavilion enter the wood and follow Green Trail.  
**Terrain** : Firm. Some gradients.  
**Distance** : 1 mile to Strid.

## BOLTON ABBEY VILLAGE TO THE CAVENDISH MEMORIAL FOUNTAIN

From the village green turn left down the road and right down the drive marked 'No Cars'. Go straight on past the Priory, through the enlarged kissing gate and follow the pavement to the fountain.  
**Terrain** : Firm path. No steps.  
**Distance** : 550m.
