

## BOLTON ABBEY ESTATE FISHERY RULES

- All Anglers must be in possession of an Environment Agency Licence plus an Estate Day ticket or Season Rod Pass when fishing
- As the Estate does not operate a beat system anglers are free to move up and down the river within the limits of the ticket
- The River Wharfe is a spate river, therefore, anglers are advised to contact the Estate Office prior to travelling to avoid disappointment
- Daily bag limit of 4 Trout not less than 10". All other Trout and Grayling to be returned carefully to the river
- Fly fishing only with a conventional fly rod and reel
- Barbless or debarbed hooks only. No hooks larger than a standard twelve or tandems, doubles or trebles to be used
- Use of lures or reservoir flies is prohibited
